11.00 A talk about the history of this unique place and William Penn's association with it. Delivered by Roger Wilson ..Clerk

The Blue Idol Quaker Meeting House, where Quakers still worship, was one of the first established after the Toleration Act of 1689. Pacifist Quakerism was in part a reaction against the turbulence and violence of the English Civil War, and was aided by the relatively recent availability of the Bible in English and the new affordability of printing. From this Meeting, William Penn sailed to found Pennsylvania, and to lay one of the foundation stones of the Constitution of the USA. The building is Grade 2* listed by Historic England and has recently been restored with their aid and considerable donations and loans from Quaker and other sources. The talk includes a summary account of this restoration.
